**A very warm welcome to our new Kindy parents at Yeo Park Infants School.**

The Yeo Park Infants School P&C is an association consisting of parents of the school, our School Principal and interested members of the school community. At Yeo Park, the P&C and the school have a very strong and positive relationship.

We work together to support our school through a variety of fundraising events, the sourcing and selling of school uniforms and assisting the teaching staff in the establishment of school policy. All monies raised are used to benefit the school in providing educational resources for all of our children.

Everyone is welcome to join the P&C and attend the meetings. It costs \$1.00 and you can join any time throughout the year. Being a member gives you the right to vote at meetings and to hold positions in the association. All P&C positions fall vacant at the AGM held in early February.

## **Upcoming information and events:**

- **P&C meetings** - are held during school terms, usually on the second Wednesday of the month in the school library at 7pm.
- **P&C committees:** There are several committees that may interest you (eg fundraising, social, lunch and cake day); these organise events during the school year.
- **Cake Day:** whenever we have a P&C meeting, we have a cake day. Cake day is enjoyed by the children immensely. Cakes are sold during crunch & sip at 2pm.

### ***What you can do:***

- If you would like your child to buy a cupcake/cake/slice place 50c in your child's crunch & sip bag
- If you can (there is no obligation to bake) you may bake cupcakes/slices/cakes and bring them in a container that is labeled with your name or child's name to the school hall

### ***Remember we are a NUT free school***

- If you have time and are able to: arrive at school at 1.45 to set up the cake stall and sell cakes.
- Left over cakes are sold after school
- Remember to pick up your container after school

- **Special Lunch Day** – Once a term the P&C prepares and serves a lunch for the whole school, usually held on the last Friday of the school term. You can assist in a variety of ways, for example, cook, cut up fruit, and serve lunch to the students.
